

Simply Giving Frequently Asked Questions

Simply Giving is an electronic giving program that provides Saint Peter members with the convenience of meeting your Good Faith Intention of Support via electronic fund transfers.

How does Simply Giving work?

A debit will be taken from your checking account once a month on either the 1st or the 15th of each month. (your choice)

Who manages this process?

Vanco Services, an outside agency, manages the process through a secure network.

What are the benefits to Saint Peter Church?

There is greater financial stability through predictable contributions.
There is improved confidence in meeting financial obligations and goals.

What are the benefits to you?

Simply Giving offers the convenience of automatic offering.
No more make-up offerings. Never needs a stamp or even an envelope.
Confidence in knowing that your Good Faith Intention of Support will be fulfilled each year.

What if I want to make a change to my Simply Giving or just stop it due to a life event?

A simple call, an email, or a hand written note to the Financial Secretary, Don Brenner is all that is needed.

How do I contribute for special appeals or fund requests?

You may use any available envelope in the pew or special needs basket by including your name or assigned envelope number. You may use the special envelopes in your box or use a plain envelope.

How do I sign up?

Simply fill out the Simply Giving authorization form and mail it to the Financial Secretary – Don Brenner or drop the form in the Financial Drop Box in the Fellowship Hall.

What happens then?

The Financial Secretary will enter your information and the electronic giving will begin on the date you specified on the authorization form. If for some reason, the deduction is not made, you will be notified and the reason explained.
