PASTOR NICK

1. Sunday's outdoor service attracted the occupants of 57 cars.
2. Still recording services – have been 1000+ hits
3. Has started putting Wednesday services online
4. FM Radio frequency has been acquired – information for the congregation will be forthcoming
5. Vicki will explore a kind of dropbox that can be used for any donations that people might want to make at the Sunday services.
6. There will be services for Holy Thursday and for Good Friday.

RICK

Rick has enough of his MOW volunteers who want to prepare the meals for April 11. The problem that emerges is in the development of a safe delivery system for the meals. MOW will have to be given more thought. It may well be that we find some way to support the County effort to make certain no one goes hungry. Rick and others will be pondering this

ROD

As the MOW discussion moved along, Rod suggested we develop some kind of a fund to allow Saint Peter to reach out and help people through the course of this COVID crisis. We could set a target amount, but we know the congregation will want to be supportive.

DAVE

Dave had offered some suggestions in terms of outreach within and beyond the congregation.

1. Some kind of picnic or congregational event at the end of the COVID crisis to help bring the congregation back together in some kind of social way.
2. See if there is a way we can offer meals to the nurses at Doshier. Bess Holt offered some suggestions. Dave will check with local restaurants and the staff about this.
3. He emailed Colleen Weathers to see if there was anything the MOM'S group, the confirmands or Sunday School students may need. He emailed her response to members of the committee.

CONTINUING OUTREACH

1. Possibly have members of the congregation make protective masks. Dottie Capriotti is already doing this for hospice. She will be contacted about how we might develop this idea.
2. Have more programs like Bible Study or Book Club on Zoom.
3. Develop an ARTS PROJECT, taking advantage of some of the skill sets of the congregation.
4. Postings on Facebook and the Website can offer outreach to the congregation.

VICKI

1. Doug Morgart is preparing to offer some telemedicine information.
2. We have to tighten up access to the office and copy machine. People are coming in in a potentially unsafe way to use the machine. The key will be removed from the sanctuary and the office locked. Should people need something copied, it can be put in Judy Morehouse's mailbox, with instructions, and she will take care of it.
3. The Shepherds are following up with people who can use followup information and help.
