PASTOR NICK

1. People are being encouraged to use the website.

DALE GIANNATASIO

Dale has been serving on a Synod Task Force in developing a plan on how the NC Synod can move forward as a united whole. Churches will be encouraged to move forward slowly, carefully. The group hopes to finalize a document on Tuesday. At this point, recommendation will probably include:

1. Groups should be limited to 10.
2. Keep a strong online presence even after the physical opening of facilities.
3. Vulnerable populations like the elderly need to be careful.
4. Follow the examples set by the schools.
5. Liability and the attendant insurance policies need to be taken into consideration.
6. Step-by-step process as we move along
7. No communion for a while with largely spoken services.

To keep congregations safe, we will need to increase the number of services.
