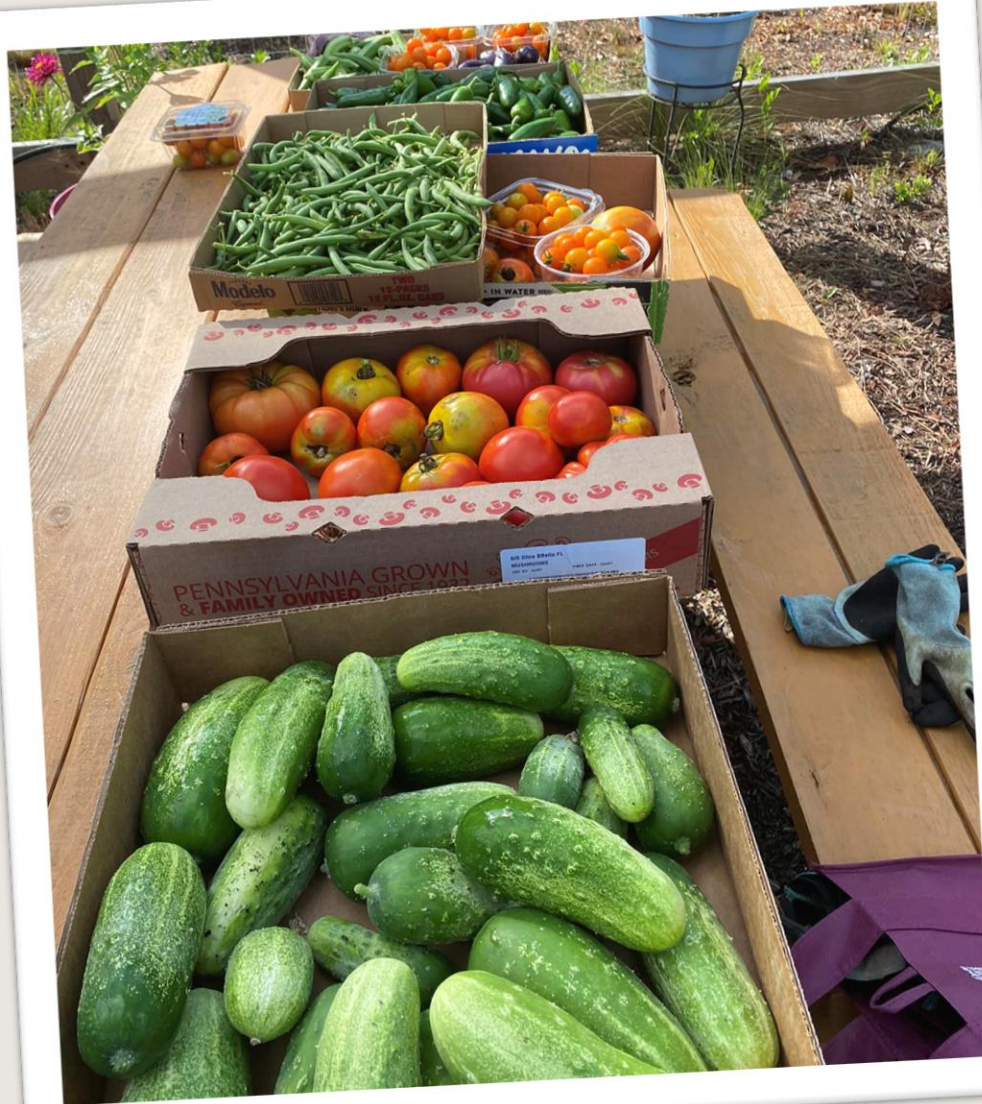

With the growing season in full swing, we're thrilled to report that the end of July total was about 800 pounds - more than double our total from July '22!
