Purpose

- To minister to the elderly who might otherwise not have access to a worship service.



What we do:

- Two months each year, the Outreach Committee provides worship services at a local nursing home as part of the Southport Oak Island Interfaith Church Fellowship (SOIICF).
- The service begins at 10:15 and lasts about 30 minutes, so it doesn't conflict with either service.
- Nursing home residents enjoy a non-denominational Christian experience each week.
- The residents really respond to this simple worship service, and especially enjoy singing the wonderful old hymns.
- The service includes a devotion and singing, then closes with the Lord's Prayer.
- Devotional readings can be of your choosing, or from Our Daily Bread (copies are in the narthex).

Needs



- We need four people to conduct each Sunday service: one to give a short message, one to play the piano, and two persons to help move residents to and from their rooms.
- Additional volunteers, though not necessary, significantly enhance the worship experience.
