WHAT WE DO

The Outreach Committee provides oversight for the many activities at Saint Peter designed to reach out to and support our neighbors in Southport and surrounding communities, including efforts through the Southport-Oak Island Interchurch Fellowship (SOIICF).

Efforts in need of immediate volunteers:

- Meals on Wheels needs packers and drivers every second and fifth Saturday
- Giving Garden needs harvesters for an hour on Mondays and Fridays to gather produce for the SOIICF Food Pantry
- SOIICF Food Pantry needs volunteers to sort donations and stock shelves

MORE OF WHAT WE DO

Other efforts we staff from our membership:

- Nursing home ministry – we perform devotion services two months each year
- Kairos prison ministry – volunteers visit, lead worship & studies, and fellowship
- Live Nativity event – we need actors, guides, and food servers
- Winter Warmup coat donation event every other fall
- SOIICF interfaith events
- Special events and other outreach opportunities

WHERE WE HELP

Each year, the Outreach Committee arranges benefits to help support these programs:

- StreetReach, supporting ministry to the homeless
- A Safe Place, supporting this Wilmington ministry's ongoing fight to eradicate human trafficking in Brunswick and New Hanover counties
- Matthew's Ministry, working with local schools to provide food for needy children
- Monthly tuition for two students in Haiti to attend elementary and middle school
